Laurel Activities

In order to encourage the use of indigenous names for individuals and groups, the Palimpest Herald (the "Rules" Herald) has posted proposed changes in the Standards for Evaluation of Names and Armory to state that names of "indigenous tribes and other groups of people" can be protected if they have an entry in a standard print encyclopedia, such as the Encyclopedia Britannica "or an equivalent non-English encyclopedia."

Likewise personal names may be protected if they have an entry in a standard print encyclopedia, such as the Encyclopedia Britannica "or an equivalent non-English encyclopedia." Newly famous individuals may rarely be considered important enough to protect even if they have not yet appeared in a print encyclopedia.
